PRIVACY POLICY

1. Data Collected & How We May Use Your Data

DCS also logs IP addresses, or the location of your computer on the Internet, for systems administration and troubleshooting purposes.

We will use commercially reasonable measures to protect the security and integrity of your personal information. While we have taken reasonable steps to limit the uses of information provided by you to those described in this Privacy Policy, we cannot guarantee that the information will remain permanently secure. We shall not be responsible for the loss or disclosure of your information due to errors in transmission or the unauthorized acts of third parties, unless caused by our gross negligence or willful misconduct. DCS is not responsible for the content or the privacy policies of websites to which DCS or related products or services may link.
